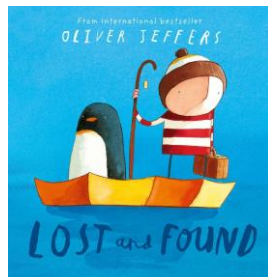
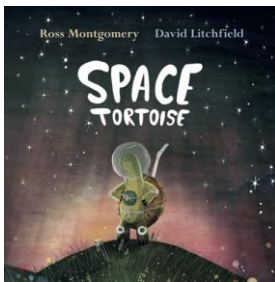


Year 1 Newsletter

Uniform
