### Uniform

Please label **all** items of your child's school uniform. Please remember that children should be wearing a school jumper/cardigan that has the **school logo** on it. Children are **only** permitted to wear **black** school shoes or trainers; boots are not allowed. Please ensure your child takes their **earrings** out before school, as they are **not** permitted due to health and safety regulations.

### Weather

As the weather is colder and much wetter, we ask that you send your child in an appropriate coat that has their name **clearly labelled**. Children are still likely to remove their coats on the playground on a warmer day and last term we had a significant number of children who misplaced their coats as well as jumpers. We also recommend that you provide your child with a **water bottle** – the children are able to refill these during the day.
