Whole School Project

This term our whole school project is **Banksy**. You may have already noticed our special Banksy painting in the playground! This term we will be looking closely at this painting and recreating our own Banksy-style artwork. We will also be focusing on the United Nations Rights of the Child and how every child has the right to relax, play and take part in a wide range of activities. We will be thinking about what our favourite things to do are, how we feel when we are relaxing or playing and also thinking about our hopes and dreams!

Our termly topic is...

Our topic this term is **Traditional Tales.**We will be reading different traditional tales such as, *The Gingerbread Man* and *Goldilocks* and the *Three Bears*. We will be exploring good and bad characters in the stories and making lots of exciting crafts linked to the stories that we are reading. We will also be recreating scenes from our favourite stories and thinking of our own endings to the stories that we have read!



Literacy and Maths Learning

In Reception, this term we will be writing speech bubbles for characters from our stories; creating recipes and acting out parts of a story. We will also be starting Phase 2 phonics. This involves learning letter sounds, practising forming sounds and hearing the sounds in words.

In Maths this term, we will be exploring the world of Numberblocks! This will help us with recognising and comparing numbers, and understanding the composition of numbers up to 5. We will also be learning about pattern, shape and sorting objects by their type, size or colour!
