Our termly topic is:

Our topic this term is 'All About Me.'
For our topic we are going to be thinking about ourselves, our family and how families are similar and different. We will also be thinking about people who help us in our community and will learn about the nurse Mary Seacole. We will also be learning about different countries and ways of life.

Literacy Learning

In Reception, this term we will be exploring writing captions for pictures and will start to learn how to write sentences. We will be starting our Phase 3 phonics sounds. These involve digraphs which are 2 letters that join together to make one sound, such as, ai, ee.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our school values for this term are **Resilience** and **Honesty**. We will be learning about these values in circle time as well as looking at what they mean to us as a class. We will have our '**Road Safety**' workshop this term too. This will help to teach us how to cross the road safely and we will be putting what we learn into practise during our local area walk next term.

P.E.

The Reception children have really been enjoying our P.E. sessions so far! Children will need to come to school in their P.E. kit on their P.E. day. They will then stay in their P.E. kit for the whole school day. For P.E. they will need a white top, black jogging trousers or shorts, school jumper or black sweatshirt (no hoods) and sensible running trainers or plimsols.
