Home time

As we begin a new school year, please ensure you introduce yourself and anybody who will be regularly collecting your child to the new teacher as soon as possible. Please ensure that you are arriving promptly at 3:30pm to collect your child from the playground. If somebody different is collecting your child, it is essential you notify the office and your child's class teacher in advance. If we have not been advised about a change in pick up, we will **not** allow your child to leave until we have spoken to you directly. Parents who are late to pick up their child regularly may be fined.

Uniform

Please label **all** items of your child's school uniform. Please remember that children should be wearing a school jumper/cardigan that has the **school logo** on it. Children are **only** permitted to wear **black** school shoes or trainers; boots are not allowed. Please ensure your child takes their **earrings** out before school, as they are **not** permitted due to health and safety regulations.

Weather

As the weather is still warm, we ask that you please label your child's jumper, as they will be more likely to remove it and missing jumpers can therefore be returned swiftly. Last academic year, we had a significant number of children who misplaced their jumpers. We also recommend that you provide your child with a water bottle – the children are able to refill these at any point during the day and are able to take them out onto the playground.

Whole School Project - The Tempest

We will begin this term with a whole school project focussing on **The Tempest**. The children will be learning about the story and the characters. In English, we will be using the text to write a diary entry and character descriptions. We will also be creating some artwork based on **The Tempest**.
