


Reception Newsletter

Our topic this term is:

People Who Help Us!

For our topic we are going to be thinking about who helps us in our family and who also helps us in our local community. As part of our learning we will be hearing from parents on how they help others. We will also be finding out about different occupations and reading the story 'The Jolly Postman!'



Literacy Learning

In Reception, this term we will be writing thank you cards to thank those that help us as well as writing about what jobs we would like to do when we are older. We will be starting our Phase 3 phonics sounds. These involve digraphs which are 2 letters that join together to make one sound, such as ai and ee.

Hug-A-Bug

We hope the Reception children are enjoying their hug-a-bug book and positive affirmation heart at home. We will be introducing the children to the characters Bella Bee, Cress the Caterpillar and Sedric Snail this term and will learn about what it means to be brave and unique! Maths Learning

In Reception, this term we will be learning about the composition of numbers 6, 7 and 8. We will find different ways to make the numbers using Numicon, 10 frames and counting beads. We will also be learning about mass, capacity, length and height! We will be finding different ways to measure using resources in class such as balancing scales.

Our whole school project this term is learning about the life and work of Floella Benjamin. In Reception, we will be learning about Floella Benjamin's experience of moving to England by reading her story 'Coming to England.' We will also learn about the different jobs that she did and will be thinking about how we can help children that are new to our school.
