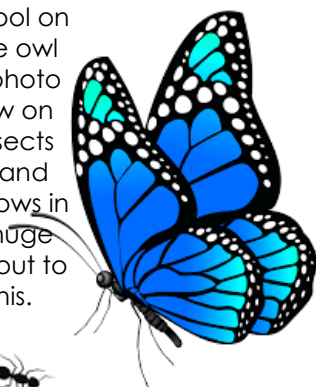
This topic is always lots of fun and inspires lots of wonderful language and artwork.
