Our topic this term is:

For our topic we are going to be learning about animals from all over the world. We will be reading stories such as 'The Leopard's Drum' and we will be watching the Netflix series 'Our Planet' to support our learning on animals.

Literacy Learning

In Reception, this term we will be writing our own non-fiction books and will write facts about the animals that we have learnt about. In phonics, we will be focusing on Phase 4. This is when we learn to read and write words that contain more than one syllable. We will also learn lots of new tricky words!

Animal Workshops

To support your child with their learning in our topic this term we have arranged two exciting workshops for your child that will both be held in school. They will be taking part in an 'Owl Show' and a 'Rodents and Reptiles' show. During both workshops the children will have an opportunity to pet the different animals that have been brought into school and will learn many new facts about them! 


Maths Learning

In Reception, this term we will be learning about the composition of numbers 9 and 10. We will also be practising our number bonds to 5 and will be working on being able to remember what the bonds to 5 are without working them out. We will also be learning about 3D shapes and will be exploring ways to make 3D shapes with 2D shapes.



This term, we will be reading the story 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and we will be designing and making our very own healthy fruit kebabs for the hungry caterpillar! We will be visiting our local Sainsbury's to purchase the ingredients for our fruit kebabs!
