We hope that you have had a wonderful Easter break. Please find below some useful information for this term and a very warm welcome to Miss McCallum joining the nursery team this term in NBM!

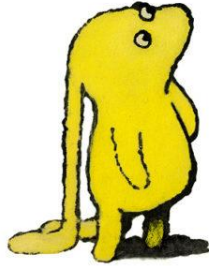

Our termly topic is... Our Wider World.

We will be reading lots of stories about planet earth and space this term such as Beegu, Man on the moon and Aliens love underpants as well as learning about the moon.

This topic is also a great opportunity to introduce the children to some beautiful non-fiction books about space and planet earth.

WonderDome Visit

To support our learning on Space the children will be watching an exciting planetarium show in school. We will be having a visit from 'The Wonder Dome' where the children will get to explore their space dome. They will have the opportunity to learn through an interactive dome projection.
