Our Termly Topic is:

We will be reading different stories and non-fiction texts that focus on art and colour such as: *The Magic Paintbrush*; *Brown Bear, Brown Bear* and *Elmer*.

We will also explore the topic of music by reading books such as *Tanka, Tanka*, *Skunk* and by listening to poems including *Pete the Cat*.

If any parents have specialist skills in this area- e.g. they play an instrument, we would love to have you in to play for the children (or please film yourselves for us to watch later). We think you will find them a brilliant audience!
