Our topic this term is:

### Night and Day

We will be reading different stories that focus on night-time, such as, *Peace at Last*, *Owl Babies* and a non-fiction book on *Nocturnal Animals*. We will also be thinking about how night time is different to day time .



### Literacy Learning

This term we will be writing about nocturnal animals, listening to Firework poems and discussing celebrations that we share with our family. We will be continuing with Phase 2 phonics and will also start to learn to read and write short words.

### Maths Learning

This term we will be continuing to learn about the composition of numbers to 5. We will find different ways to make 5 using Numicon, 5 frames and counting beads. We will start to learn about addition and subtraction and will be also learning about 2D shapes and the routines of our day.



### Anti-Bullying Week

Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November-Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November.

During Anti-Bullying week, we will be watching the short film 'Daisy Chain.' We will discuss why bullying is wrong and what we can do to stop bullying from happening. We will think about how we can be a good friend to others and what to do if someone is being unkind.



### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our school values for this term are **Peace** and **Tolerance**. We will be learning about these values in circle time as well as looking at what they mean to us as a class. We will also be watching the 'Daisy Chain' during Anti- Bullying week. We will discuss why bullying is wrong and what we can do to stop bullying from happening.

### Forest School

This term we will be starting our Forest School sessions in Reception. Forest School is an initiative originating in Scandinavia, which provides children with natural outdoor learning experiences to support and enhance their independence, self-esteem and creativity across the curriculum. The children also develop their skills in working collaboratively.
