Inspiring Writing

In reading and in writing, children will be exposed to different genres to inspire various writing outcomes. Taking inspiration from our class text

The Explorer and our South America topic, we will be writing jungle survival guides. We will then explore the horror genre, before going on to study Shakespeare's Macbeth.





Uniform

Please label all items of clothing with your child's name to enable us to return lost property to the correct child. Children should be wearing a school logo jumper and black shoes or trainers. Home Learning

Your child must read at home, each night wherever possible, in order to make good progress. Parents/carers can help pupils by reading alongside with them and by asking questions in relation to the text. Parents /carers are asked to acknowledge this through a signature once a week. The journals are checked in school regularly.

Your child will continue to receive weekly spellings alongside additional maths tasks. These will be set on Friday and must be completed by the following Friday.

Physical Education

P.E. days will remain the same as last half term: 5SA – Monday and Wednesday 5DM – Wednesday and Friday 5FB – Tuesday and Friday Children can wear a PE kit for the duration of the day when they have a PE lesson. As the weather is now starting to become colder the pupils are expected to bring in warmer, suitable clothing to stay warm. The units are **orienteering and football**.

Mobile phones

If travelling independently into school, children are allowed to bring a mobile phone. These must be handed into the child's class teacher every morning. They will be returned to the children at the end of the school day.

Foundation topics

In our **science** lessons this term, our topic is Earth and Space. Children will be taught the planets in our solar system and how the orbit and rotation of the Earth and the Moon give us seasons and day and night. In **geography**, we will be learning about the physical properties of South America. Our **R.E.** topic is Christians Festivals, and in **PSHE** we will be exploring living in the wider world, discussing future job / career prospects, and learning how to handle and budget money.

This term, we will explore the value of **peace**. We explore our values in depth through assemblies, PSHE lessons and across the wider curriculum. We will also be exploring the theme of **tolerance**.
