## Whole School Project

This term our whole school project is **The Secret Garden** by **Frances Hodgson Burnett**. We will be reading the text as a class and will be acting out key scenes from the book. Many of our learning outcomes this term will be based on the text.



## Our termly topic is...

Our topic this term is **Traditional Tales**. We will be reading different traditional tales such as, *The Gingerbread Man* and *Goldilocks and the Three Bears*. We will be exploring good and bad characters in the stories and making lots of exciting crafts linked to the stories that we are reading. We will also be recreating scenes from our favourite stories and thinking of our own endings to the stories that we have read!



## Literacy and Maths Learning

In Nursery, we will be learning to read and recognise our names. We will begin to make letter shapes in different forms, such as using playdough and in the sand. We will also be beginning the foundations of phonics with listening games.

In Maths this term, we will be using number songs such as *Five Little Speckled Frogs* and *Five Little Ducks* to practise counting to 5. We will also be using Numberblocks to support our maths learning.
