Our topic this term is:

## Our World and Beyond

For our topic this term we are going to be learning about our local area and how it has changed over time. We will also be learning about different places around the world and how they are different and similar to each other. We will be reading the non-fiction book 'My First Book on Planets' where we will find out about how Earth is different to the rest of the planets in the solar system.



### Literacy Learning

In Reception this term, this term we will pretend to visit the planets in our solar system and will write a postcard from our chosen planet! In phonics, we will be focusing on Phase 4. This is when we learn to read and write words that contain more than one syllable. We will also learn lots of new tricky words!



### Animal Workshops

During the workshop, the children will have an opportunity to pet the owls, as well as learn many new facts about them! 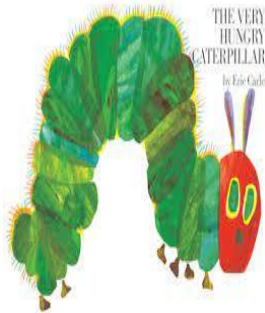
### Maths Learning
