Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our ongoing commitment to keeping everyone safe, we would like to remind families of our expectations regarding road safety and travel to and from school. Our approach aligns with Royal Borough of Greenwich and Transport for London (TfL) road-safety guidance.

Parking and Road Safety

Please park safely and legally at drop-off and collection times, avoiding yellow lines, junctions, crossings and driveways. Inconsiderate parking places children and pedestrians at unnecessary risk.

Pavements, Paths and School Grounds

Pavements and paths should remain clear for pedestrians at all times. For safety reasons, no one should ride bicycles or push scooters anywhere within the school grounds. Children must dismount on entry and walk with their equipment to the storage areas.

Bikes and Push Scooters

We encourage active travel. Bicycles and push scooters may be brought to school and stored only in the designated areas provided. These are stored at the owner's risk, and the school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage. Bikes and scooters must not be left on paths, near entrances or in walkways.

E-scooters and E-bikes

Privately owned e-scooters are illegal to use on public roads and pavements and are not permitted on the school site. For this reason, e-scooters and e-bikes must not be brought onto school grounds and cannot be stored in bike or scooter areas.

School Responsibility

The school's authority applies within the school grounds only. Enforcement on surrounding roads and pavements rests with the Royal Borough of Greenwich, Berkeley Homes and the police. However, we continue to raise concerns with Greenwich Council and Berkeley Homes regarding the local road layout and safety.

By working together and modelling safe behaviour, we can help keep everyone in our community safe.
