We hope that you had a restful break, and the children are ready for another fantastic term at Wingfield! We have many exciting learning opportunities for your child this term!



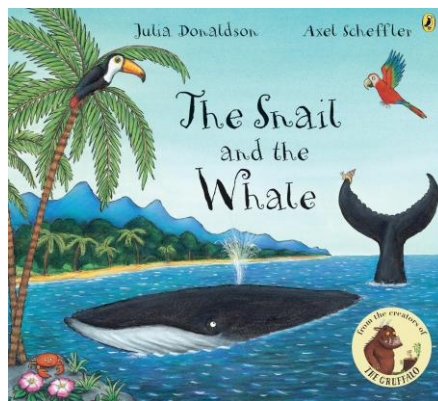
Our topic this term is:

Animal Adventure!

For our topic this term we are going to be reading texts linked to animals including dinosaurs! We will engage in a variety of fiction texts including *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* and *The Snail and the Whale*. We will also read a variety of non-fiction texts including *My First Book of Dinosaurs*. Our writing outcomes will be linked to the book we are reading each week.

Embers

This half term, we will continue with our PSHE curriculum around Embers the Dragon. We ask that you support your child with this by accessing the website from home. Maths Learning

In Reception, this term we will continue to practise our number bonds for 5 and 10. We will be learning our doubles to 5 and we will also explore how to share out amounts, halve objects and how to halve quantities. We will be practising counting above 20 and will start to learn about money!
