Welcome back to another exciting term at Wingfield! We hope you have had a restful and enjoyable holiday. We are looking forward to starting the summer term. We have got lots of exciting learning planned!

## Our Summer 1 Curriculum

In **English**, we have begun reading **Voices in the Park** by Anthony Browne and we are looking forward to writing a retell of the story through the perspective of one of the characters! We also have many exciting texts to explore this term such as, **Fluffy Flying Seed, The Search for the Giant Arctic Jellyfish, Our Tower, Meerkat Mail and The Girl at the Front of the Class.**

In **Maths**, we will continue our learning on place value to 100, whilst beginning to learn how to count in 5s and 10s. We will also be learning about money and will be ordering coins by their value. We will add money together and will use our knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to support this.

## Embers

At Wingfield, we follow the Embers programme for part of our PSHE lessons. This term we will be focusing on the 'Instructions' and 'Problem Solving' parts of the programme. There is an introductory topic with a video for parents, and an animation and activities to enjoy with your child.

## Our Summer 1 Foundation Curriculum

In **Science**, we will be focusing on plants this half term. We will be growing our own plants and will be going on a local area walk to spot different types of plants and trees! In **R.E.**, we are learning about the religion Judaism and how Shabbat is celebrated and why it is important to Jewish people. We will be studying the U.K. in **Geography** and will be locating key countries and cities on a map and comparing towns with more rural locations. Our **Art** topic is sculpture and mark making, we will be planning a sculpture of the Cutty Sark and will then create our plans!



## Showbie and Home Learning

Thank you to all who have been regularly completing Home Learning. Please continue to support your child's learning by listening to your child read every evening and spend time discussing what the book is about. Please record your child's reading in their journal- the name of the book and a signature is fine. You can find a paper copy of the Home Learning activities in your child's bag every week, which is also available on Showbie. We encourage you to complete these activities with your child, as it is a great way for them to share and discuss their learning journey with you.



## Physical Education

On PE days, pupils will be expected to attend school dressed in their P.E. kit for the whole day – normal school uniform is not required on these days. Children wearing earrings to school will be asked to remove them. The children will have P.E. sessions each week, this includes an outdoor P.E. session.
