We hope you all had a wonderful Easter break and are feeling rested and ready for the new term.

Curriculum

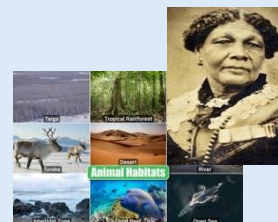
Here are some of the subjects we will cover this half term:

In **History**, we are learning about important people from the past. We will learn about Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale, and compare life in the past with today.

In **Art**, we will draw using different techniques and materials. We will create pencil and charcoal drawings and learn about shade, tone, and the importance of light and dark.

In **English**, we will explore a variety of writing techniques. We will write our own instructions for making *George's Marvellous Medicine* and a letter from the perspective of George's grandma. We will also explore and analyse poetry.

In **Maths**, we will learn about symmetry and patterns, while consolidating our understanding of the four operations and applying them to reasoning and problem-solving tasks.



Our new **Science** topic is habitats. We will learn about different types of habitats and how animals adapt to survive in their habitats.

Physical Education

On PE days, children are expected to attend school wearing their PE kit for the entire day; normal school uniform is not required. Therefore, children do not need to keep their PE kit in school during the week.
