This year, our EYFS (Nursery and Reception) Wingfield Sports Day will take place on Friday 22nd May 2026 at Crofton Albion Sports club, Weigall Road. A map detailing its location can be found at the bottom of this letter. There is a payable parking system on Weigall Road and there is also some free parking on Lyme Farm Road.

All children should **come to school wearing PE kit**: black shorts or joggers, comfortable trainers and a coloured top representing their house. The class teacher will send out a slip detailing your child's colour (red, blue, yellow or green) for sports day. Please ensure your child has **plenty of drinking water** and **applied sun cream** if needed.

Two parents/carers per child are welcome to attend the EYFS sports day but **must arrive no earlier than 9.30am**.

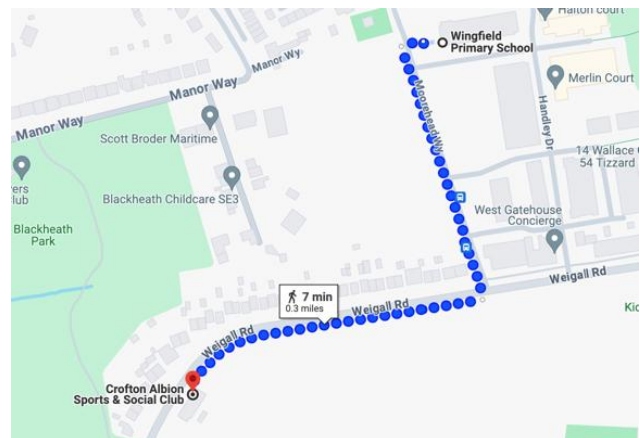
If you are available to walk your child's class **to** and **from** the venue, please let their class teacher know.

Children in EYFS will be grouped into four houses, all of which will be represented by a colour and named after one of the role models used to celebrate our school values. On the day, children will be required to wear a suitable top in their house colour. Details of your children's house and colour will be sent home, but please check with the class teacher if you are unsure what colour t-shirt your child needs to wear. Children will also need a packed lunch to eat once they arrive back at school. If your child usually receives a free school meal, this will be provided by the school kitchen. If you are unable to provide a packed lunch, please order one from the school office by **Friday 15th May 2026**.

At the end of the morning, there will be the highly anticipated parent and staff race for those who wish to participate. If you wish to take your child home at the end of their sports day, please ensure that you walk back to school with your child and collect them from there.

There are toilets and drinks facilities on site and a member of staff trained in first aid will be present throughout the entire day.
