UKS2 Sports Day – 21st May 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

This year, our UKS2 (Years 5 and 6) Wingfield Sports Day will take place on **Thursday 21st May 2026** at Sutcliffe Park Sports Centre from 1:30pm – 3:00pm. A map detailing its location can be found on the bottom of this letter. There is a payable car park service on the site. During the afternoon, the children will participate in a range of field events and a range of track running races; where parents/carers are invited to watch and cheer on.

Two parents/carers per child are welcome to attend the KS2 sports day but must arrive **no earlier than 1:00pm**. Please enter through the large metal side gate by the car park, not the main indoor entrance for Sutcliffe Park Sports Centre. The viewing area is directly next to the running track, under the stand, behind the barrier.

All children should **come to school wearing kit**: black shorts or joggers, comfortable trainers and a coloured top representing their house. The class teacher will send out a slip detailing your child's colour (red, blue, yellow or green) for sports day. Please ensure your child has **plenty of drinking water** and **applied sun cream** if needed. Children will also need a **packed lunch** to eat in school **before** they head to Sutcliffe Park. Should your child usually receive free school meals, this will be provided by the school kitchen. If you are unable to provide a packed lunch, please order one from the school office by Friday 15th May 2026.

The children have been grouped into four houses, all of which will be represented by a colour and named after one of the role models used to celebrate our school values. On the day, children will be required to wear a suitable top in their house colour. Details of your children's house and colour will be sent out, but please check with the class teacher if you are unsure what colour t-shirt your child needs to wear.

During the day, children will have the opportunity to take part in a variety of different field events showcasing their throwing, jumping and coordination skills. Children will be scored not only on their athletic ability, but also on their sportsmanship and how well they represent Wingfield school values and learning dispositions. The children will also compete against each other in a range of track events that encompass skill, speed and teamwork. Points will be given to those finishing in 1st, 2nd or 3rd in these races and the points will be combined with those scored during the field events. Parents are welcome to come and watch these track events and will be expected to cheer and encourage all competitors.

Towards the end of the day, whilst points are being totaled and winning houses decided, there will be the highly anticipated parent and staff races if you would like to participate. **If you wish to take your child home at the end of their sports day, please ensure that you walk back to school with your child and collect them from there.**

The winning house of Sports Days will be announced the following week during an assembly and in the newsletter.

There are toilets and drinks facilities on site and a member of staff trained in first aid will be present throughout the entire day.

We hope that you are able to attend this annual event, which promises to be a fun-filled and very energetic day!
